For example, members approved as Emeritus at the NAR Mid-Year or Annual meetings in 2017 would have their National and State dues waived starting in 2018.

Emeritus members are still responsible for paying the local dues annually. Upon approval, each REALTOR® Emeritus member will receive a congratulatory letter, certificate and 40-year REALTOR® Emeritus lapel pin. If you believe that you fulfill the requirements to achieve REALTOR® Emeritus status as defined above and would like to have all future national and state dues waived, please download and submit the REALTOR® Emeritus application.
